## City of San Saba Flood Resources and Information

We would like to thank everyone for their patience during this catastrophic event. Listed below are some guidelines that will help guide you through the recovery process.

- 1. Baptist Disaster Relief is in town and are setup behind the First Baptist Church with showers and laundry if needed.
- 2. Baptist Disaster Relief mud out crews will be here this week and will assist with the removal of flooring, sheetrock and spraying to prevent any onset of black mold. This is a free service, but you will need to complete an assessment form. If you want to request help from a mud out crew, your info from Istat will be provided to Paula Wood and someone will reach out to you. If you want to sign up for your home to be on the mud out list, please text 833-235-0453.
- 3. To prepare your home for the mud out crews, please remove all furniture and debris from your home. Volunteers should be here on Tuesday, July 8<sup>th</sup>, and be available to assist families with the clean out process. David Dean, 214-796-2746, will be organizing clean out times if you would like to assist your neighbors.
- 4. For debris management, please place your trash out on your curb. Please separate to the best of your ability into vegetation brush, trash and white goods (appliances, hot water heaters, stoves, fridge, etc.) and City crews will come by and pick up. If you are in the County, please reach out to the County officials.
- 5. Trash cannot be taken to our city facility. There are specific rules and regulations on how flood debris is handled and disposed of. Basic rule is to place all your flood related debris on your curb for City crews to dispose of. Individuals can put their debris on a trailer, tarp it and haul to the landfill in Brownwood. There may be a fee for doing this.
