June 24, 2026

The City Council of the City of San Saba, Texas convened into a special called meeting on Wednesday, June 24, 2026 at 6:00 p.m., in the City Hall Council Chambers located at 303 S. Clear Street.

Mayor Jordan called the special called meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and Alderman Michael Nelson led the Invocation and Pledges.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Albert Stowell, Amy Foster, and Daneen Scott signed up to speak regarding the AC C1 and C2 Ordinance. Mayor Jordan explained that the Council would be pulling the Second Discussion Action Item regarding Ordinance No. 2026-06 due to not having a Super Quorum for vote and the Council has agreed to the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission to table the Ordinance and to form a work group consisting of Planning and Zoning Members, City Staff, City Council, Professional HVAC/Engineering occupation that could provide guidance to discuss the issue and that Ordinance No. 2026-06 be tabled or pulled from the agenda until feedback is received from the work group. Amy Foster, Attorney, remote worker at home, pulled from Consideration. Mayor Jordan explained they could leave or they were welcome to stay.

DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEM:

The first action item was to Discuss, consider and take possible action approving Ordinance No. 2026-05, an Ordinance of the City of San Saba Texas, amending the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of San Saba to Provide for Zoning of Smoke Shops and Game Rooms; Providing Findings of Facts; Providing an Open Meetings Clause; and Providing an Effective Date. Mayor Pro-Tem Shawn Oliver made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2026-05, an Ordinance of the City of San Saba Texas, amending the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the

City of San Saba to Provide for Zoning of Smoke Shops and Game Rooms; Providing Findings of Facts; Providing an Open Meetings Clause; and Providing an Effective Date, seconded by Alderman Michael Nelson, and was approved on a 3 to 0 vote.

Mayor Jordan said that the Council agreed to table or pull the item regarding Ordinance No. 2026-06 due to not having a Super Quorum for vote and the Council has agreed to the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission to table the Ordinance and to form a work group consisting of Planning and Zoning Members, City Staff, City Council, Professional HVAC/Engineering occupation that could provide guidance to discuss the issue.
