

**MINUTES
BUDGET WORKSHOP

July 28, 2026**

The City Council of the City of San Saba, Texas convened into a Budget Workshop on Tuesday, July 28, 2026 at 6:00 p.m., in the City Hall Council Chambers located at 303 S. Clear Street.

At 6:03 p.m. Mayor Pro-Tem Shawn Oliver called the meeting to order, announced a quorum present, and Alderman Michael Nelson led the Invocation and Pledges.

BUDGET WORKSHOP

A budget workshop was conducted and presented the proposed budget requests for the 2026-2027 calendar year for the following departments:

County Judge Jody Fauley presented to the City Council addressing City/County Budget Matters to include Police Dispatch Services and Flood Plain Management Services. After a lengthy discussion, the City Council agreed for Dispatch Services the City would be responsible for paying \$111,125.00 per year instead of the 125,288.39 requested by San Saba County. The City Council also agreed that the City would not enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the County for Flood Plain Management Services for the \$12,000.00 yearly requested amount but would send the City's Code Enforcement Officer Shane Moore to training for certification as a Flood Plain Manager.

City Manager Scott Edmonson presented General Admin. (Expenses).

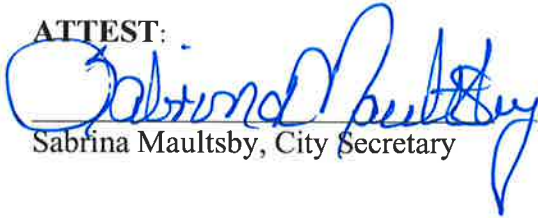
No final decisions were made regarding budgets at this meeting, and the final Budget will be voted on at the August meeting.

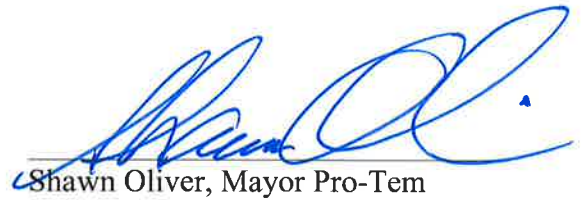
